Areas of Learning

As Historians, we will be learning about World War 1. We will find out about how the war affected soldiers and those who stayed in Britain. We will share the story of the famous Christmas football match and will re-enact key events.

As Geographers, we are going to visit some incredible biomes via the magic of Google Expeditions. We will discover where the First World War was fought and will find the countries involved on maps.

As Musicians, we will be learning songs for our nativity. We will listen to, perform and sing popular songs from World War 1. Pack up your troubles etc.

As Scientists, we will be finding out about the human digestive system and different food groups.
