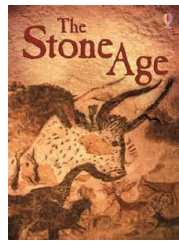
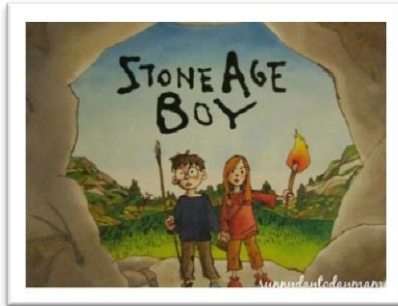




Hazel Class Y3/4 - Autumn 2 2017



In **Literacy** we will be focussing on features of Non-Chronological Reports and will link our writing to our Anti-bullying/cyber bullying work in **PSCHE** and our Stone Age work in **History**. We will also be learning about how to publish our writing on Pobble in order to share with a much wider audience and receive positive feedback on how well we are doing. 😊

In **Numeracy** we will be focussing on formal written methods of calculation for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Some of us will be using inverse operations to check the accuracy of our methods. We will also be solving a range of number puzzles and word problems.

As **Historians** we will be studying what life was like during the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. We will learn about food, clothes, homes, tools, weapons, beliefs and arts and crafts. We will also look at the changes to these aspects of life during the transitions between each period. As **Artists** we will create our own Cave Paintings and Rock Art depicting aspects of everyday life during The Stone Age.

As **Design Technologists** we will design and build our own Stone Age shelters in the woodland and will also create Christmas decorations from natural materials.

As **Musicians** we will be learning and rehearsing the fantastic new songs for our Nativity, 'Lights, Camel, Action!'. In **Computing** we will compose our own musical masterpieces using apps on the ipads to simulate a range of instruments, rhythms and beats.

In **P.E** we will be choreographing our amazing Oompa loompa dance with a Specialist teacher, which we will rehearse weekly in preparation for our performance at the Strictly Pennine Dance, at the LBT, in February!

In **R.E** we will focus on how Art is used in Christianity to represent the life and teachings of Jesus. In December, we will focus on depictions of the Nativity and will hopefully create our own contemporary designs.

As **Scientists** we will be focussing on Light and Sound. Year 3's will learn about how light is reflected from surfaces and how shadows are formed. They will investigate how the size of a shadow can be changed. Year 4's will learn about how sounds are made and will investigate how pitch and volume are affected by the strength of vibrations and the features of the object producing them.
