

Areas of Learning

As Geographers we will be exploring the distribution of water around the world. We will be looking at famous rivers and identifying where they are situated, alongside exploring the journey of a river.

As Historians we will look at the experiences of Grace Darling and Christopher Columbus. We will also be looking at the Titanic Disaster.

As Scientists we will link our topic a lot cross-curricular. We will be looking at states of matter and changing states alongside looking at the water cycle. We will apply our understanding to learning more about the environment and getting outdoors to develop our woodland.

As Artists and Designers we will be doing lots of practical activities linked to water. *As Musicians* we will develop a soundscape to support our poems.

As Writers we will be creating some water inspired poetry. Then we will be moving onto our focus text the BFG and working on activities based around that.

As Mathematicians we will begin with data handling, linking this with our computing topic 'we are opinion pollsters'. We will also be developing our problem solving skills and mental maths skills to build techniques to allow us to dissect word problems accurately.

In our specialist PE sessions this half term will be looking at Tri-Golf.
