Areas of Learning

As Historians we will be exploring the significance of the royal family. Firstly, we will look in detail at the Victorian era then move onto comparing this to modern times. We will look at the legacy of monarchs past and present.

As Scientists we will be exploring the science of sound. We will learn about how we hear and link our Science to music. We will be carrying out investigations to support our enquiries alongside linking in computing by making sound using digital technology.

As Musicians we will be looking at iconic and traditional British songs and singing in rounds. Alongside this we will be working hard to prepare for the nativity and exploring the story in R.E.

As Artists we will look at famous British artists and develop techniques inspired by them. We will also be doing a photography project, linking together computing and art.

As Writers will be focusing on developing characters and scenes before moving onto non-fiction writing. Again, a focus will be on spellings and handwriting.
