Areas of Learning

Our topic this half term is Let's Explore, we will be focussing our learning on all things in space.

In maths we will be learning about fractions of shapes and numbers. We will also look at measuring and different units of measurement. We will continue as always with number work throughout the half term.

In literacy we will continue to practise our cursive handwriting ready for joining up. We will also look at different space themed genres of writing such as poems, stories and non-fiction texts.

As Historians we will be investigating the life and work of famous astronauts such as Neil Armstrong and Tim Peake. We will be comparing their experiences and seeing how things have changed.

As Scientists we will be learning about different materials which we think may be in space and also looking at the solar system.

As Artists we will be making planets and rockets using different materials and techniques including using paper Mache. We will look at the surface of the planets choosing appropriate materials to create effect and also mic appropriate colours.

In computing we will using recording devices to record ourselves and begin to use the bee bots to programme movement.

In PE we will again be welcoming a specialist PE coach. This half term the children will be learning gymnastic skills.

In RE we will be looking at special stories from different religions, and begin to look at the Easter story.

Our continuous curriculum will be in space/ the space station.
