Areas of Learning

Our topic this half term is Long Long Ago, we will be focussing our learning on dinosaurs and 'the land before time'.

As Historians we will be investigating different dinosaur species, how they lived, when they lived and what the world was like when they were around.

As Scientists we will be learning about different animals and grouping them into different categories.

As Artists we will be printing and looking at different patterns and printing effects. We will incorporate our knowledge about dinosaurs to choose appropriate colours and patterns.

In computing we will be programming the bee bots making simple algorithms and de bugging.

In PE we will be learning skills to golf.

In RE we will be looking at special stories from different religions, and begin to look at the Easter story.

Our continuous curriculum will be dinosaur land.
