Areas of Learning

As Geographers and Historians we will be finding out about and locating the 'Wonders of the World'. We will look at how settlements are formed and how structures were built to last in different eras. We will also look at our local community history by going on a walk around our local area and finding out about what it used to be like.

As Scientists we are going to be learning all about 'Skeletons and Muscles'. We will be looking at how our body is built to protect us and provide us with structure. We will be linking this into PE by thinking about which muscles are working whilst we carry out a range of physical activities.

As Artists and Designers we will look at construction in a range of ways, exploring how to make structures strong. We will link this to the 'Wonders of the World' looking at how their construction was carefully planned, linking this with our Mathematical knowledge. We will create a model of our village, Slaithwaite.

As Writers we will look at using our descriptive writing techniques to describe the findings inside King Tutankhamen's Tomb. We will then move on to exploring fairy tales with a twist.

As Mathematicians we will be learning to tell the time accurately using both analogue and digital clocks. We will then move onto 3D shape. Throughout this we will continue to solidify our written methods.
