Areas of Learning

As Historians will learn about famous artists and a range of techniques that have developed through time. We will look at different eras and how perceptions of 'What is art?' changes through time.

As Scientists we are going to be learning all about Light and Shadows. We will also link this into recapping on plants and looking at how plants use light to develop and grow, as well as finding out about seed dispersal.

As Artists and Designers we will be developing and using a range of techniques inspired by different artists through time. We will link in our Science work to create a model person with a range of different shadows. We will look at traditional forms of art as well as more modern forms such as digital artwork. We will use our computing skills to solve problems and bug fix. We will look at how music is an art form and can inspire different thoughts and emotions.

As Writers we will be focusing on letter writing in a range of ways. We will look at using persuasive language and applying our grammar skills to develop formal letters. We will also look at informative letters which will allow us to apply our knowledge of informal language and grammar.

As Mathematicians will be recapping and solidifying our knowledge from this year by carrying out lots of problem solving tasks. We will touch on areas such as money and measures to ensure we can apply what we know.

In PE our specialist teacher will be teaching athletics.

In RE we will be respecting and learning about other faiths, looking at Ramadan and Eid.

We will recap on our French skills looking at body parts and clothing.
